## Court – obstruction conviction dismissed



The US Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit affirmed the district court's dismissal of the criminal conviction of a former BP employee due to juror misconduct. The former employee had been convicted of obstruction of justice. During juror deliberation, the jury forewoman overheard a conversation in a courthouse elevator that other BP employees involved in the Deepwater Horizon oil spill were being prosecuted. She told the other jurors that this made her even more convinced that the defendant was guilty. [United States v.
