## USCG NVMC – compressed files not accepted for NOADs



The USCG National Vessel Movement Center (NVMC) posted a **notice** stating that, due to cybersecurity issues, compressed (i.e., zip) files will no longer be accepted as attachments for NOADs. Non-compressed formats, as outlined in 33 CFR Part 160, are the only authorized file formats for attachments sent to the NVMC.
